

TOP TIPS for Visitors to BARBADOS



SECURE YOUR VALUABLES WHEN TRAVELING.

Do not take your valuables, particularly passports and air tickets, on the beach. Put them away in a safe at your hotel to minimise the risk of theft.

ALL ILLEGAL DRUGS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN BARBADOS.

There is a zero tolerance policy on the use and trafficking of illegal drugs. If convicted of an offence, the crime is punishable by a hefty fine, imprisonment or both.



REDUCE THE RISK OF SKIN DAMAGE.

Use sunblock whenever you are exposed to the sun, or keep in well shaded areas.

BARBADOS IS A SAFE PLACE, BUT DON'T LET YOUR GUARD DOWN.

Maintain the same level of personal security awareness as you would at home. Avoid beaches and unlit streets at night.



PLEASE RESERVE YOUR SWIMWEAR FOR THE BEACH

Our general dress code is fairly casual, but keep your swimwear for the beach

DO NOT WEAR CAMOUFLAGE

Any form of camouflage is not allowed to be worn while in Barbados.
